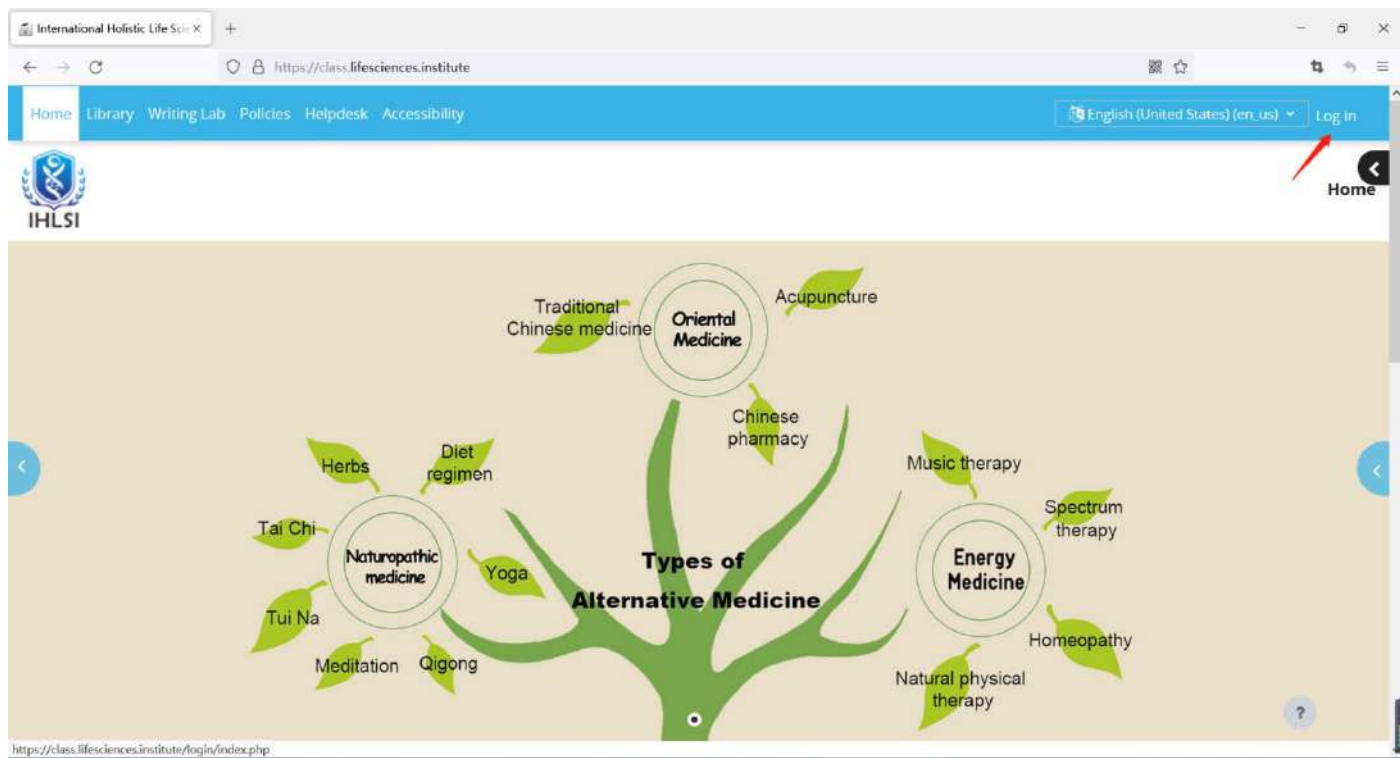
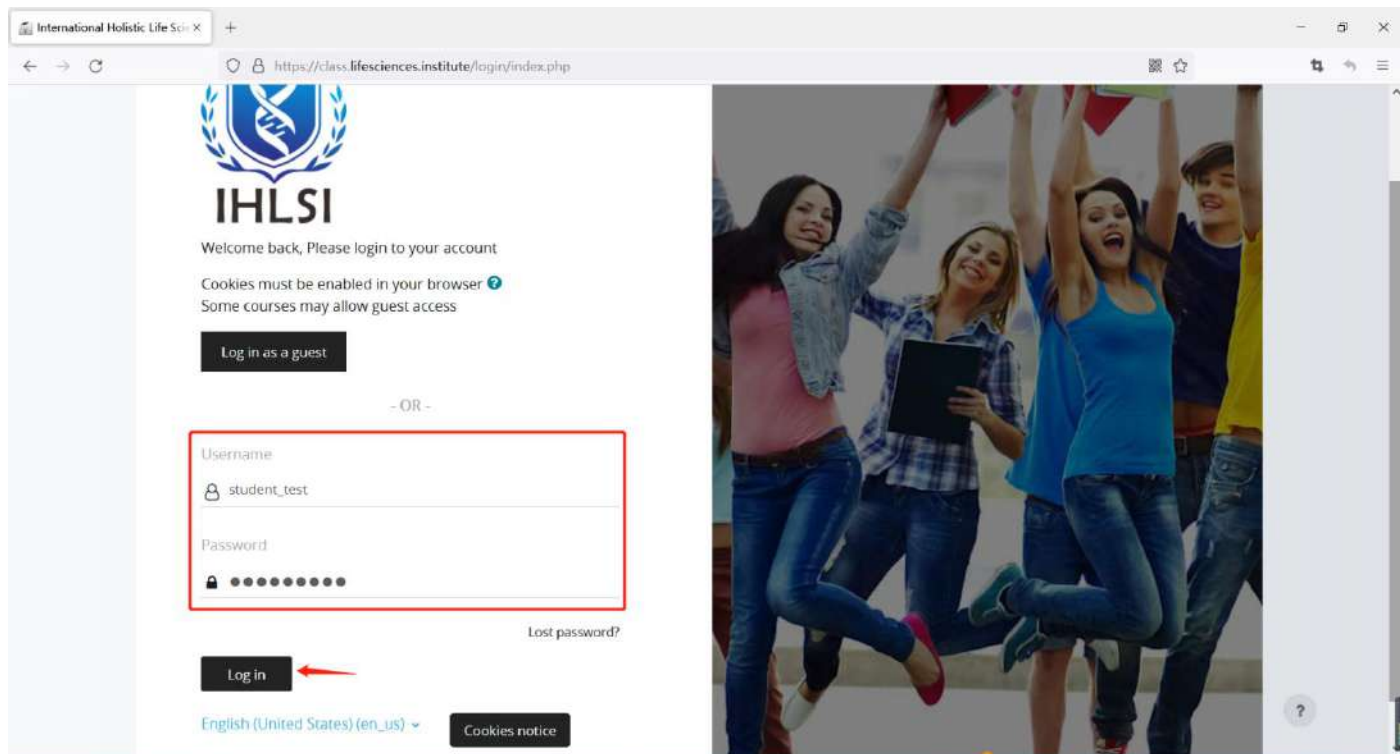


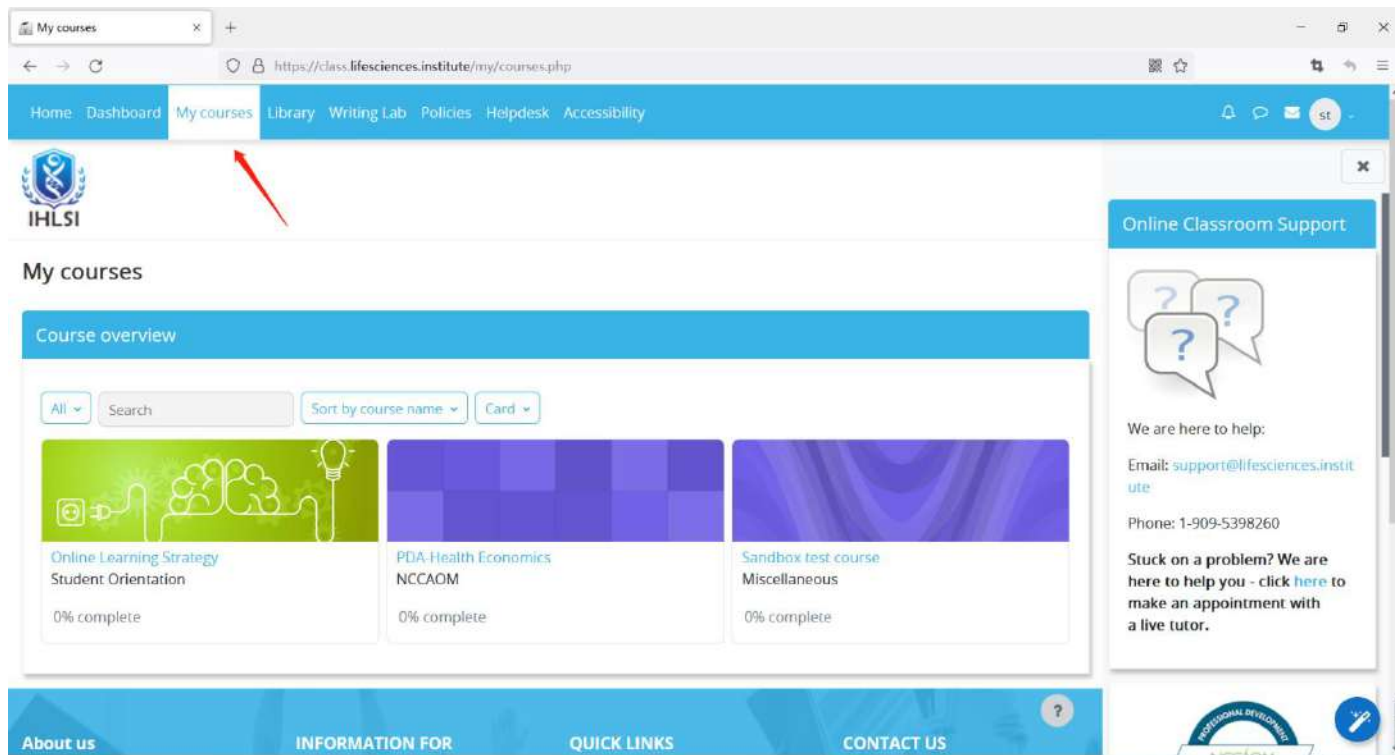
1. Go to IHLSI online classroom: <https://class.lifesciences.institute/>.



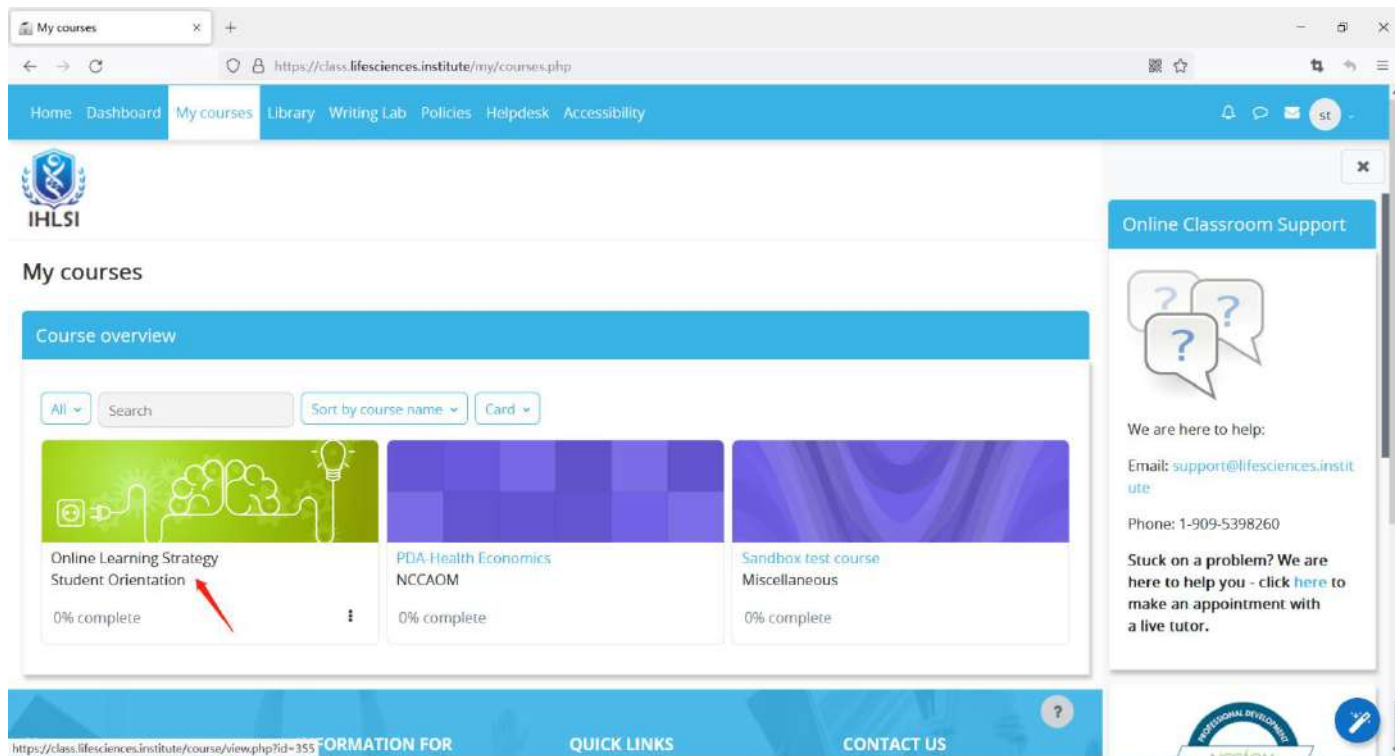
2. Enter your username and password to log in. You will need to change your password on your first log in.



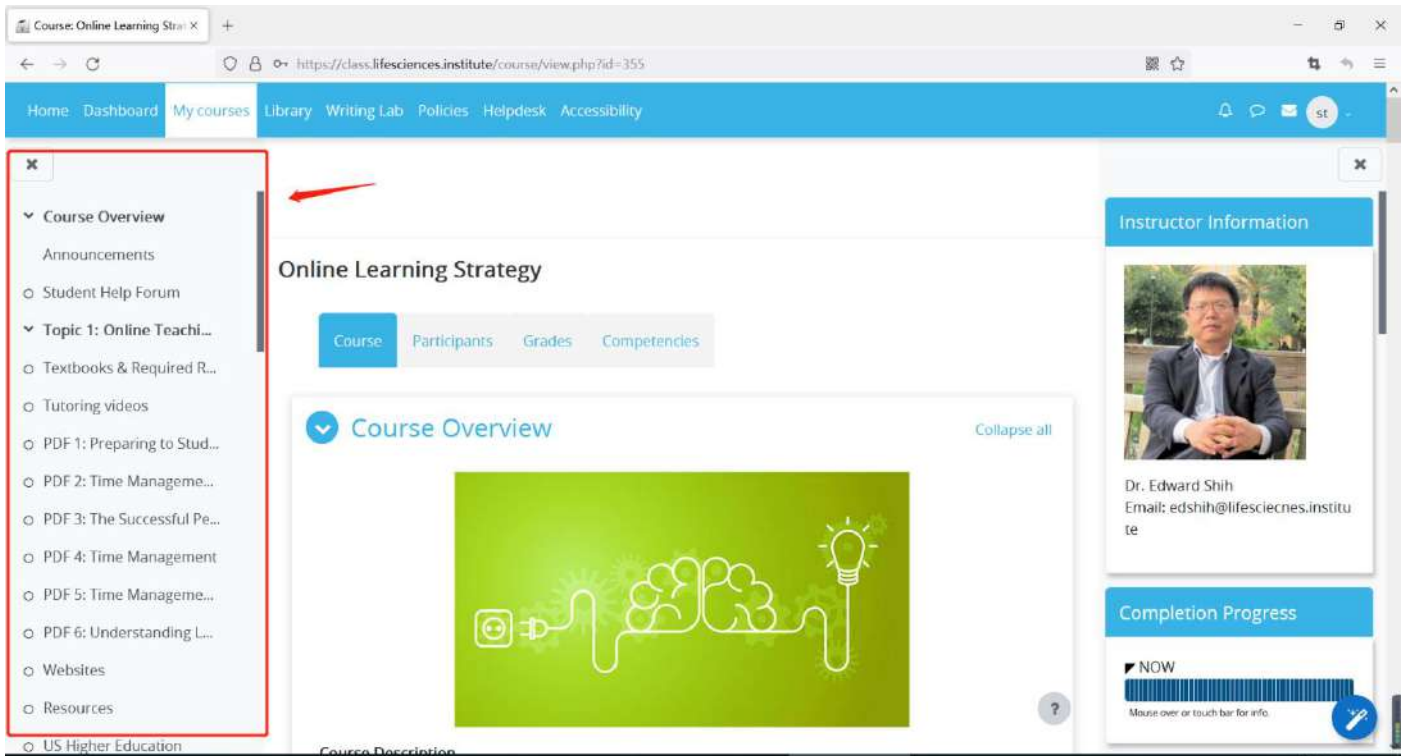
3. After login, you will find the “My Courses” tab.



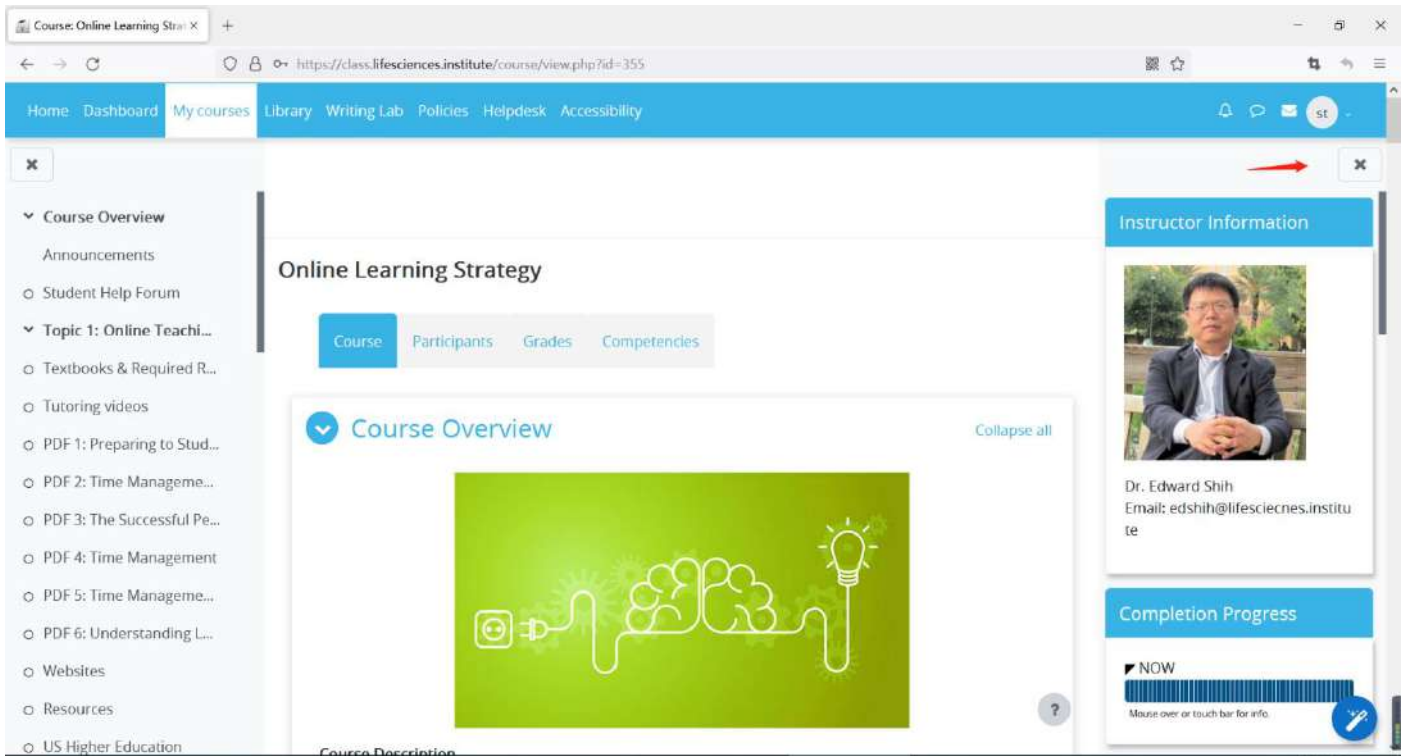
4. Click on the course module to access the class.




5. The left column shows the course structure and content.




6. Click on the "X" to close the page.



7. Check the Announcement Forum each week to review weekly due dates and to stay on track with coursework.

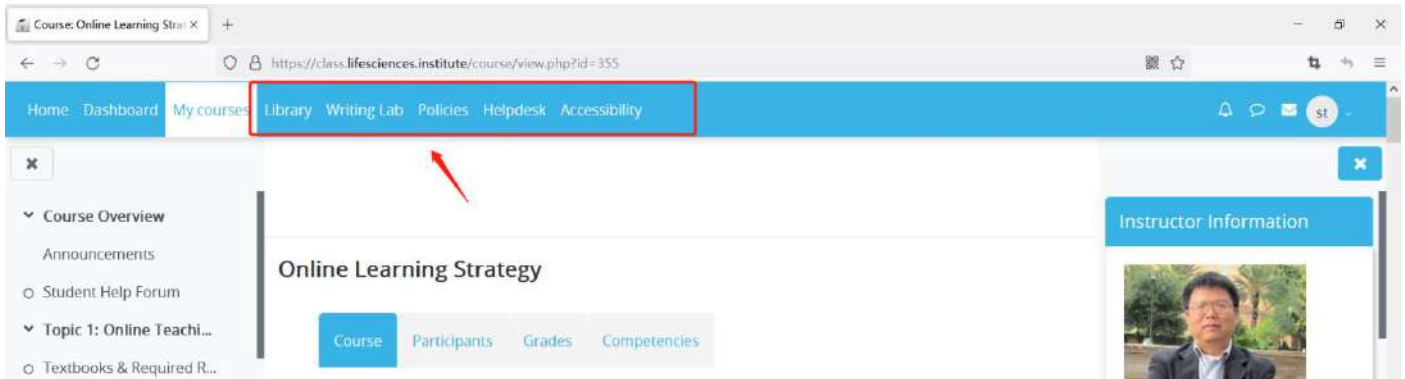

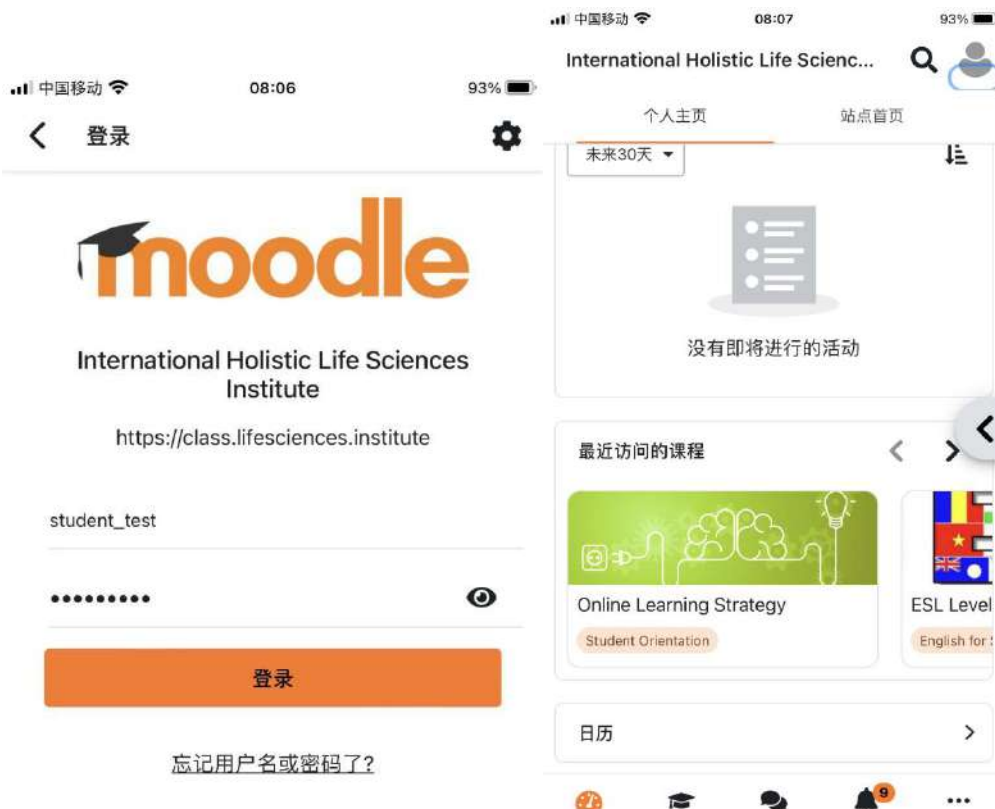
### 1. Download Moodle App
