Master of Sciences in Complementary and Integrative Health

# **Appendices**

## **Glossary**

**Certificate Students:** Refers to those students enrolled in International Holistic Life Sciences Institute's online graduate certificate program.

**Study Group:** A group of students who complete courses together toward the same degree.

**Course Support Team:** The team members, including Teaching Assistants (TAs), Learning Project Leaders (TLPs) and Course Managers, who provide support for individual courses.

**Course Unit:** A course unit (CU) is a standard unit that measures academic workload over some time, usually corresponding to a semester (fall, spring, or summer). CU (or part thereof) represents the academic workload in different types of educational programs and is a fundamental component in pursuing a degree. One CU is usually equivalent to one semester of four-credit courses.

**Degree Students:** Refers to those students enrolled in International Holistic Life Sciences Institute's online graduate degree programs.

**Lecturer/Professor:** Your course lecturer, a team of teachers from the International Holistic Life Sciences Institute, is an expert in their field. They will guide you through the course.

**Student Account:** Your username and associated password in the International Holistic Life Sciences Institute authentication system. You need to register a student account before accessing services authenticated using this system.

**Student ID number:** A unique eight-digit number issued by the International Holistic Life Sciences Institute and its affiliated institutions. University administration often requires student ID numbers for identity verification, replacing the previous practice of using an individual's Social Security number. Student ID card holders will find their student ID number printed on the card - an 8-digit



sequence on the card.

**Teaching Assistant (TA):** A teaching assistant is a student employed by a professor to assist in teaching courses. They are responsible for grading assignments and providing feedback to students during office hours.
